MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING**

June 17, 2026

SPECIAL MEETING CONCERNING RATE STUDY

On June 17, 2026, Rock-Moore Public Water Authority held a special meeting concerning the new rate study conducted by Crist Engineers. All Directors were in attendance including Director Hopper who attended through zoom. Also, in attendance was Attorney Edward Boyce. After several months, Crist Engineers has completed our rate study per ACT 605 with findings to be approved by the Rock-Moore Board of Directors and submitted to the state of Arkansas by July 1, 2026.

President Carter called the meeting to order. He, then, turned the meeting over to Manager Richardson. ACT 605 is mandatory for all water systems. A rate study is required every five years and prior to any major development project to help water systems maintain a 1.10 debt ratio. Future capital improvements affect these rates. Manager Richardson provided examples of different scenarios including all necessary capital improvements and rates, or do partial improvements/rates, or no improvements/rates. Crist Engineers, also, provided a sample notification Rock-Moore could issue to customers of the proposed rate increases. Mr. Boyce suggested Rock-Moore, also, include an explanation of ACT 605 and perhaps distribute a notification to each customer individually. After much discussion, Secretary-Treasurer Nash made a motion to accept the rate study as presented with all necessary capital improvements noting changes can be made in the future. Director Bobrosky made a second and the motion carried.

The meeting was adjourned with a motion by Secretary-Treasurer Nash and seconded by Director Bobrosky. The motion carried.
